7 adjustment claims and hope to have those submitted to the United States Government
8 shortly. In an effort to pursue this alternative remedy, the parties stipulate to continue the
9 Case Management Conference to a later date. The parties stipulate to continue the Case
10 Management Conference to June 25, July 2, or July 9, 1010.

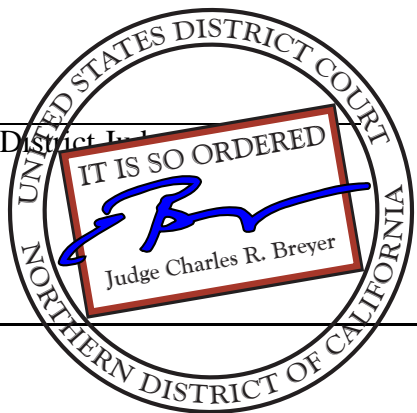
