17	had neither paid the filing fee nor applied for leave to proceed in forma pauperis ("IFP").
18	Plaintiff was informed that the case would be dismissed if he did not either pay the fee or
19	remedy the IFP deficiency within thirty days. Although he has provided an application to
20	proceed IFP, he has not completed the "Certificate of Funds in Inmate Account," page five of
21	the application. Because plaintiff has had many cases in this court, he must have been aware
22	that failure to complete the application would lead to dismissal.
23	Because plaintiff's application is incomplete, leave to proceed in forma pauperis
24	(document number 4 on the docket) is DENIED . This case is DISMISSED without prejudice. See
25	Fed. R.Civ.P. 41(b). The clerk shall close this file.
