11 miscellaneous cables and connectors.

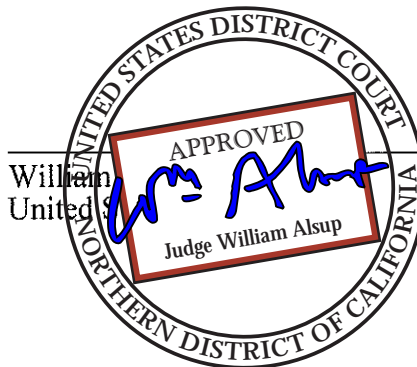
12   **[PROPOSED] ORDER**
