1 WHEREAS, the complaint in this action was filed on January 13, 2009;

2 WHEREAS, this Court appointed Lead Plaintiff in this matter on February 9, 2009;

3 WHEREAS, Lead Plaintiff has not yet filed an amended complaint;

4 WHEREAS, Defendant Taleo Corporation intends to file a restatement of its financial
5 results with the Securities and Exchange Commission;

6 WHEREAS, Lead Plaintiff intends to file an amended complaint after Defendant Taleo
7 Corporation files its restatement;

8 WHEREAS, the undersigned parties wish to avoid burdening the Court with unnecessary
9 motion practice;

10 WHEREAS, a case management conference is currently scheduled for April 24, 2009;

11 WHEREAS, based upon the above, the parties agree that the case management
12 conference should be extended;

13 IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED AND AGREED, by and between the undersigned,
14 subject to approval of the Court, as follows:

15 1. Lead Plaintiff will file an amended complaint within 30 days after Defendant
16 Taleo Corporation files its restatement with the Securities Exchange Commission;

17 2. Defendants need not respond to the original complaint;

18 3. Defendants will respond to the amended complaint within 45 days after Lead
19 Plaintiff files the amended complaint;

20 4. If Defendants' response is a motion to dismiss, Lead Plaintiff's opposition will be
21 due 45 days after the motion to dismiss is filed and Defendant's reply will be due 30 days after
22 that.

23 5. The case management conference is extended to September 11, 2009.

24 6. Any hearing on a motion to dismiss will be noticed for three weeks after Defendant's
25 reply is due.


