(See Stipulation at 1:26-27.) Moreover, the parties fail to 19 address the effect of their proposed extension on the remaining pretrial dates, such as the 20 February 22, 2010 deadline to disclose experts and the March 5, 2010 deadline to file 21 dispositive motions, and on the June 7, 2010 trial date. 22 Accordingly, the Stipulation is hereby DENIED without prejudice. 23 IT IS SO ORDERED. 24 25 Dated: January 21, 2010 26 ed States District Judge
