**ORDER RE DEFENDANT'S
SUGGESTION OF

The Court is in receipt of defendant's suggestion of bankruptcy and applicability of the automatic stay under 11 U.S.C. 362. The parties may, if they wish, file a response thereto (limited to three pages), by **APRIL 1, 2009**.
