24 disposition. Accordingly, the parties shall inform the court, by way of the enclosed form, whether
25 they consent to Magistrate Judge James' jurisdiction or request reassignment to a United States
26 District Judge for trial. The parties shall inform the Court of their decision by May 14, 2009.
