STIPULATION AND [PROPOSED] ORDER TO SET BRIEFING SCHEDULE AND HEARING ON
 DEFENDANTS' CONTEMPLATED MOTION(S) TO DISMISS - CASE NO. C 09-1001 SI

1 **WHEREAS**, on April 27, 2010 the Court issued an Order Granting Defendants’ Motions
2 to Dismiss and Granting Plaintiffs Leave to Amend (the “April 27th Order”);

3 **WHEREAS**, on May 11, 2010 the Court granted Plaintiffs leave to file a Second
4 Amended Consolidated Class Action Complaint for Violation of the Securities Act of 1933, 15
5 U.S.C. § 77 *et seq.*, and the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, 15 U.S.C. § 78 *et seq.* (“Second
6 Amended Complaint”) on or before May 28, 2010;

7 **WHEREAS**, Plaintiffs’ Second Amended Complaint was filed with the Court on
8 May 28, 2010;

9 **WHEREAS**, Defendants intend to file motions to dismiss with the Court as soon as
10 practicable;

11 **WHEREAS**, the Parties agree that this is a complex case involving intricate issues of law
12 and procedure;

13 **WHEREAS**, the Parties, having conferred about their respective schedules, agree that the
14 agreed upon schedule set forth, *infra*, is in the best interests of the parties and the Court in order
15 for full and comprehensive briefing to be presented on Defendants’ contemplated motion(s) to
16 dismiss;

17 **WHEREAS**, the Parties also agree that it makes sense to postpone the next case
18 management conference (currently set for July 9, 2010, at 2:30 p.m.) to the same day as the
19 hearing on the forthcoming motions to dismiss;

20 **NOW, THEREFORE**, the Parties stipulate and agree as follows:

- 21 1. Defendants shall file with the Court their motions to dismiss on or before July 2,
22 2010;
- 23 2. Plaintiffs shall file their opposition(s) to defendants’ motions to dismiss on or
24 before July 23, 2010;
- 25 3. Defendants shall file their repl(ies) on or before August 6, 2010; and
- 26 4. Defendants shall notice their motions to dismiss for hearing on September 3, 2010,
27 or, if the Court prefers, a later date chosen by the Court.
