Before the Court is plaintiff Sophie Vrabel's response, filed April 17, 2009, to the Court's March 27, 2009 order directing plaintiffs to show cause why the instant complaint should not be dismissed.¹ In her response, Sophie Vrabel, through counsel,² concedes the initial complaint fails to state a claim under either federal or state law, and requests leave to amend.
