Local Rule 3-12. The court has denied petitioner's § 2255 motion in his criminal case, effectively closing that action. (See Case No. 3:03-cr-00095 WBS, Docket No. 853.) Further, because petitioner's civil case includes separate parties, allegations, and issues from his criminal case, it does not appear that there will be an unduly burdensome duplication of labor if these two cases are conducted before different Judges.
