Address the medical opinions, giving appropriate weight to the opinions of the treating 27 physicians where warranted; 28

1	3. Provide a residual functional capacity finding consistent with all evidence of record;
2	4. Reassess the claimant's credibility; and
3	5. Obtain new vocational expert testimony. Specifically, the Administrative Law Judge
4	(ALJ) shall obtain supplemental vocational expert testimony. Such testimony should provide
5	reasonable explanations for any conflicts between the testimony and the United States
6	Department of Labor's <i>Dictionary of Occupational Titles</i> . It should also cite jobs (if any) that an
7	individual of Plaintiff's age, education, work experience, and residual functional capacity
8	could perform.
