Furthermore, counsel for both parties (including Messrs. May, Loebs, and Lewis) will be trying 1 a case in state court starting on January 3, 2012, which is expected to last between two and three 2 weeks. 3 Finally, the deposition of Captain Parra, currently scheduled for December 20, 2011, will need 4 to be re-scheduled due to the fact that counsel in this case are required to attend a Mandatory 5 Settlement Conference in another case, and that is the only date that the Court is available to conduct 6 the conference. Due to the trial mentioned above, the deposition will likely need to be re-scheduled for 7 late January. 8 9 To allow the Court sufficient time to rule on Plaintiff's anticipated motion, and to accommodate counsel's trial and pre-trial schedules in another matter, the parties propose a change in 10 the date of Defendant Parra's last day to file a summary judgment motion. The parties propose that 11 12 Defendant Parra's last day to file a summary judgment motion be February 27, 2012.
