 convenient to the Court.

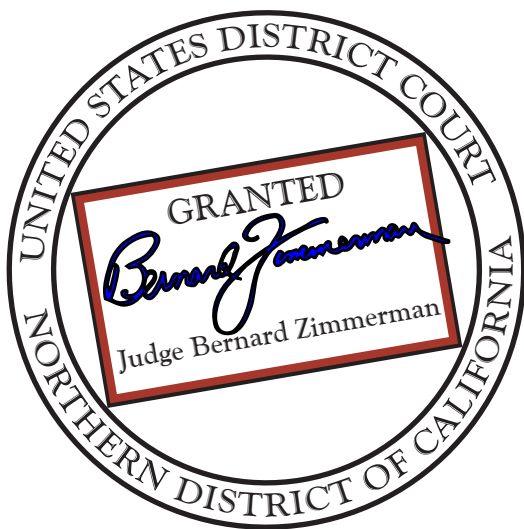
