26	Three of the defendants in this civil action are also defendants in a related criminal case,

- 27 U.S. v. Maher Fayez Kara, et al., No. CR 09-0417 MHP. Maher Kara, Michael Kara, and Emile
- 28 Jilwan are accused of securities fraud based on the same factual allegations as those made in the

Commission's civil complaint. By an order dated January 29, 2010, the Court set a criminal Trial and Motions Setting Conference on April 19, 2010. The defendants in the criminal action told the Court they need additional time to review evidence and pursue a resolution of the case. The Court has not yet set a trial date for either the criminal case or this related civil action.

Discovery is underway in the civil case, and the Commission has produced documents obtained during its investigation, pursuant to initial disclosure obligations and defendants' document requests, and defendants have responded to the document requests served by the Commission. The parties have conducted two third-party depositions, and have agreed to reschedule others in order to attempt to resolve the claims in the civil case.

## STIPULATION TO CONTINUE STATUS CONFERENCE AND DISCOVERY
