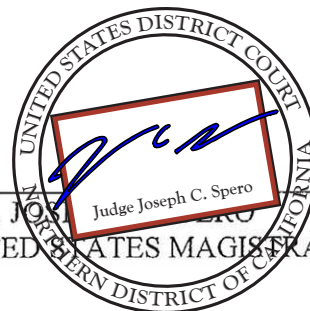
Good cause appearing, it is hereby ORDERED:
