1 Defendants have filed six Motions in Limine [Docket #73, #74, #75, #76, #77
2 and #78]. The parties stipulate that Plaintiff Johnson may have until October 14, 2011 to
3 respond to those motions based on the following good reasons.

4 First, the parties have cooperatively worked toward completion of depositions
5 which have involved considerable effort and travel every week for the past month, with
6 the last deposition completed just yesterday (Sept 29). Second, the parties are scheduled
7 to participate in a private mediation next week (Oct 6), and effort is now directed
8 toward the mediation. Third, the court has reset trial and the hearing on pending
9 Motions in Limine (and the Pretrial Conference) by approximately four months.
10 (Docket #86). Thus, the short extension is reasonable.

11 Accordingly, counsel respectfully request an order extending the deadline for
12 plaintiff to respond to defendants' Motions in Limine to October 14, 2011.
