3 Lesbians and Gays - seek to intervene on the side of plaintiffs  
4 herein, Doc #79, and seek to shorten time for that motion to be  
5 heard, Doc #85. Both plaintiffs and the intervenor defendants  
6 oppose the motion to shorten time. Doc ##88, 89. Another non-  
7 profit group - Campaign for California Families - seeks to  
8 intervene on the side of defendants herein. Doc #91.

9 In order to determine and properly align all parties to  
10 this lawsuit promptly and avoid piecemeal decision-making, now  
11 therefore:

- 12 1. Any motion to intervene herein on behalf of any  
13 interested person or entity must be filed not later than  
14 July 24, 2009;
- 15 2. Responses or opposition to all such motions to intervene  
16 must be filed not later than August 7, 2009;
- 17 3. Reply memoranda in connection with such motions to  
18 intervene must be filed not later than August 14, 2009;  
19 and the time to hear and argue all such motions to  
20 intervene are shortened to August 19, 2009 at 10 AM.

22 Accordingly, the clerk shall terminate Doc #85.
