2 ("proponents"), seek leave to file a motion for a protective order.
3 Doc #175. Plaintiffs and plaintiff-intervenor City and County of
4 San Francisco have indicated their intent to oppose proponents'
5 motion. Doc ##181, 182. To resolve the dispute expeditiously, the
6 court orders as follows:

7 Proponents shall file their motion for a protective order
8 not later than September 15, 2009. Plaintiffs and plaintiff-
9 intervenor shall file their opposition not later than September 18,
10 2009. Proponents shall file their reply not later than September
11 22, 2009. The initial motion and opposition shall not exceed
12 fifteen pages; the reply shall not exceed ten pages.

13 The court will hold a hearing the matter on September 25,
14 2009 at 10 AM.
