1 The parties and nonparties appear to be in substantial
2 agreement with respect to the outstanding discovery issues. See

4 the court finds it appropriate to allow the parties and nonparties
5 until April 22, 2010 to confer and negotiate in order to reach a
6 stipulation that will resolve remaining discovery issues. In the
7 event the parties and nonparties are unable to reach a resolution
8 of these issues, they are DIRECTED to inform the court in writing,
9 either jointly or separately, not later than 5 PM PDT on April 22,
10 2010.

11 Good cause having been shown, see Doc #632 at 7, the
12 order to show cause why the evidentiary record should not be
13 closed, Doc #631, is hereby DISCHARGED.
