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1           On January 14, 2010, plaintiffs moved to file, either  
2 under seal or as part of the public record, documents they wished  
3 to introduce at trial. Doc #414. The court resolved the matter  
4 during trial; accordingly, the motion to seal is DENIED AS MOOT.

5           On January 19, 2010, plaintiffs moved to re-open the  
6 deposition of Ronald Prentice and concurrently submitted supporting  
7 exhibits under seal. Doc #482. The motion to re-open was denied  
8 without further briefing; accordingly, the motion to seal is DENIED  
9 AS MOOT.

10           Pursuant to Civ LR 79-5(e), the court will hold the  
11 documents submitted under seal until August 17, 2010. If  
12 plaintiffs choose not to retrieve them before that date, the court
