23 Pursuant to Court order, on December 16, 2010, the undersigned parties participated in a
24 mediation conducted by Magistrate Judge Zimmerman. As a result of the mediation, counsel
25 representing plaintiff Securities and Exchange Commission (“Commission”) reached agreements in
26 principle to settle all of the Commission’s remaining claims against defendant Jasper Knabb and

2 However, before the parties can submit the proposed settlements to the Court, the
3 Commission must formally adopt the settlements through a vote of its Commissioners. In order to
4 allow the Commission to consider and vote on whether to adopt the proposed settlements, the
5 undersigned parties respectfully request that the Court: (1) vacate the current deadline of February
6 11, 2011 for the hearing of dispositive motions in this case, as well as the current pretrial conference
7 and trial dates (*see* Docket Item 75); (2) set a new deadline of May 13, 2011 for the hearing of
8 dispositive motions; (3) and schedule a case management conference for May 13, 2011, or as soon
9 thereafter as the Court’s schedule permits.
