17 The pretrial conference in this matter is set for July 12, 2011. According to the Court's Case
18 Management and Pretrial Order, no later than twenty days before the pretrial conference, the parties
19 were required to file a joint pretrial conference statement, trial briefs, motions in limine, excerpts
20 from discovery that will be offered for trial, joint proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law,
21 disclosure of expert witnesses, and exhibits. See Docket 19 at 4-7. No later than ten days before the
22 pretrial conference, the parties are required to file any objections to exhibits or to use of deposition
23 excerpts or other discovery, any objections to nonexpert witnesses, any opposition to a motion in
24 limine. Id. at 7.

25 The parties failed to file their initial pretrial materials on time. On June 23, 2011, after the
26 Court contacted counsel, the parties requested a continuance to July 1, 2011 to file their pretrial
27 materials. The Court denies the request to extend the filing date to July 1, 2011. Instead, the Court
28 reluctantly grants an extension to file initial pretrial materials to Monday, June 27, 2011 at noon.

The parties shall file any objections or oppositions to the initial pretrial filings no later than July 5, 2011. The parties are admonished to comply with this and all future court orders in a timely manner.
