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1 This matter came before the Court on an Order to Show Cause why a preliminary 2 injunction should not be issued. On June 10, 2009, the Court issued a Temporary Restraining 3 Order ("TRO") against all defendants. The Court also issued an Order to Show Cause which requires defendants to show cause, if any, why a preliminary injunction should not be granted. 4 5 Good cause appearing, the Court finds that plaintiff Securities and Exchange Commission 6 has demonstrated that it attempted to provide defendant Jin K. Chung with actual notice of the 7 TRO and Order to Show Cause. By its terms, the TRO expires at 8:00 a.m. PDT on June 24, 8 2009, unless extended by the Court pursuant to the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure. Based on 9 the Commission's papers, including the Declaration of Thomas J. Eme in Support of the 10 Preliminary Injunction, good cause exists to extend the terms of the TRO to allow the 11 Commission additional time to notify defendant Jin K. Chung of the TRO and Order to Show Cause. Pursuant to Rule 65(b)(2) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, the Court therefore 12 extends the terms of the TRO as ordered herein. 13 Therefore, 14 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT the Temporary Restraining Order against defendant 15 Jin K. Chung, entered June 10, 2009, shall be extended and will expire at 8:00 a:m. PDT on 16 July 9, 2009. See FED. R. CIV. P. 6(a)(2); FED. R. CIV.
