1           **ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION OF TIME TO SERVE DEFENDANT CHUNG**

2           This matter is before the Court on plaintiff Securities and Exchange Commission's  
3 Motion for Extension of Time to Serve Defendant Jin K. Chung. The Court previously  
4 ordered that plaintiff serve Chung by no later than March 31, 2011. *See* Order dated  
5 December 30, 2010 (Docket No. 68).

6           Following consideration of plaintiff's motion and accompanying papers, and for good  
7 cause shown, the Court grants the motion pursuant to Rule 6-3 of the Court's Local Rules.  
8 Plaintiff shall have until June 30, 2011, to serve defendant Chung with the summons and  
9 complaint.

10           In the event that plaintiff is unable to effectuate service of process by June 30, 2011 and  
11 thereafter files a motion seeking a further extension of time to serve defendant Chung, plaintiff  
12 is directed to show therein how it would be harmed if its claims against Chung were dismissed  
13 without prejudice.
