1 TO THE COURT, AND ALL PARTIES AND THEIR ATTORNEYS OF RECORD:
2 THIS STIPULATION is entered into by and between plaintiff Arturo Ching (“Plaintiff”) and
3 State Farm Mutual Automobile Insurance Company (“Defendant”), collectively referred to
4 herein as the “Parties,” by and through their attorneys of record.

5 WHEREAS, in its May 7, 2010 Order, the Court afforded Defendant leave to file a
6 second motion for summary judgment;

7 WHEREAS, in its May 7, 2010 Order, the Court continued the further case management

16 request and HEREBY STIPULATE that the briefing schedule and hearing date for Defendant’s
17 motion for summary judgment is as follows:

- 18 1. Defendant will file its motion for summary judgment by **June 25, 2010**;
- 19 2. Plaintiff will file his opposition to Defendant’s motion for summary judgment and
20 any cross-motion for summary judgment by **July 16, 2010**;
- 21 3. Defendant will file its reply in support of its motion for summary judgment and
22 opposition to Plaintiff’s cross-motion by **August 6, 2010**;
- 23 4. Plaintiff will file his reply in support of his cross-motion by **August 20, 2010**;
- 24 5. The hearing on Defendant’s motion for summary judgment and Plaintiff’s cross-
25 motion shall be held on **August 27, 2010 at 9:00 a.m.**

26 The Parties further jointly request and HEREBY STIPULATE that the case management
27 conference dates are continued as follows:
