1 Defendants' Motion to Strike Plaintiff John T. Mooney's Untimely Demand for
2 Jury Trial in the above-captioned action came on for hearing before the Court on December 4,

4 Goldman Sachs Group, Inc., and Christopher Lalli (collectively "Defendants") appeared and

6 Walker LLP. Plaintiff John T. Mooney ("Plaintiff") appeared and argued through his counsel,
7 Jacqueline C. Fagerlin, Esq. of the Cardoza Law Offices.

8 The Court, having read and considered all of the papers submitted in support of the
9 and plaintiff's statement of non-opposition thereto,
10 motion [^] ~~and in opposition thereto, the oral arguments of counsel~~ and the entire record in this
11 action, and the matter having been duly heard,

12 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

13 Defendants' Motion is GRANTED, and Plaintiff's untimely demand for a jury trial
14 on file herein is stricken, on the ground that Plaintiff failed to serve and file his jury demand
15 within ten (10) days after being served with notice of removal as required by Federal Rule of
16 Civil Procedure 81(c)(3)(B)(ii). Plaintiff therefore has waived his right to trial by jury. *See* Fed.
17 R. Civ. Proc. 38(d) ("A party *waives* a jury trial unless its demand is properly served and filed.")
18 (emphasis added).
