9 Pending before the Court is Plaintiff's Motion for attorney Matthew D. Spohn to Appear Pro
 10 Hac Vice. Upon review of the record in this action, the Court notes that Plaintiff has not filed a
 11 written consent to Magistrate Judge James' jurisdiction. This civil case was randomly assigned to
 12 Magistrate Judge James for all purposes including trial. In accordance with Title 28, U.S.C. §
 13 636(c), the magistrate judges of this district court are designated to conduct any and all proceedings
 14 in a civil case, including trial and entry of final judgment, upon the consent of the parties. An appeal
 15 from a judgment entered by Magistrate Judge James may be taken directly to the United States Court
 16 of Appeals for the Ninth Circuit in the same manner as an appeal from any other judgment of a
 17 district court.

18 You have the right to have your case assigned to a United States District Judge for trial and
 19 disposition. Accordingly, Plaintiff shall inform the Court whether it consents to Magistrate Judge
 20 James' jurisdiction or requests reassignment to a United States District Judge for trial. A copy of
 21 both the consent and declination forms may be obtained from the Northern District of California's
 22 website at <http://www.cand.uscourts.gov/>. From the homepage, click on the "Forms" tab on the left
 23 margin, then choose "Civil." The consent/declination form shall be filed by July 23, 2009.
