1 1. Pursuant to the July 16, 2009 Order Setting Initial Case Management Conference and
2 ADR Deadlines, the initial case management conference in the above-captioned case is
3 currently set for October 23, 2009 at 10:30 a.m., and the joint case management statement is

5 2. Plaintiff mailed the Summons and Complaint in the above-captioned case to the

15 conference to December 18, 2009, at 10:30 a.m. The parties jointly request that all other
16 deadlines set in the July 16, 2009 Order Setting Initial Case Management Conference and ADR
17 Deadlines be continued accordingly.


