) **JOINT STIPULATION OF DISMISSAL**

1 **WHEREAS**, on July 20, 2009, plaintiff Trans Video Electronics, Ltd. (“Trans Video”) filed
2 the Complaint in this action (D.I. 1) alleging patent infringement of U.S. Patent No. 5,991,801 (the
3 “’801 patent”) by Sony Computer Entertainment America Inc., Sony Computer Entertainment
4 America LLC (formerly Sony Computer Entertainment America Inc.), Sony Corporation, Sony
5 Corporation of America, Sony Electronics Inc. (collectively, “Sony”);

6 **WHEREAS**, on September 24, 2009 and December 15, 2009, the Sony defendants filed
7 Answers to the Complaint [D.I. 25, 26, 27, 42, and 43], and through their Answers denied having
8 committed any act of infringement of the ’801 patent and further pleaded counterclaims for
9 declaratory judgment of noninfringement, invalidity, and unenforceability of the ’801 patent;

10 **WHEREAS**, on October 14, 2011, the Court issued an Order Granting Sony’s Motion for
11 Summary Judgment of Invalidity [D.I. 139];

12 **WHEREAS**, on November 15, 2011, the Court issued an Order Denying Plaintiff’s Motion
13 to Amend Its Complaint And To Amend Its Disclosure Of Asserted Claims And Infringement
14 Contentions [D.I. 147], this order being amended on November 16, 2011 [D.I. 149]);

15 **WHEREAS**, on November 15, 2011, the Court entered its Judgment [D.I. 148] in favor of
16 the Sony defendants pursuant to its grant of summary judgment of invalidity and its denial of Trans
17 Video’s Motion to Amend;

18 **WHEREAS**, on December 5, 2011, Trans Video filed a Notice of Appeal to the Federal
19 Circuit [D.I. 150];


20 **WHEREAS**, the Judgment [D.I. 148] is not final under 28 U.S.C. § 1295(a)(1) because
21 Sony’s counterclaims for declaratory judgment of noninfringement, invalidity, and unenforceability
22 of the ’801 patent remain pending;

24 **IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED AND AGREED** that the Sony Defendants’ counterclaims
25 for declaratory judgment against Trans Video are each dismissed without prejudice, each party to
26 bear its own cost, expenses, and attorneys fees.


