14 John L. Carpenter has filed a petition for writ of habeas corpus to challenge his 15 conviction and sentence from the Nevada County Superior Court. Nevada County lies within 16 the venue of the Eastern District of California. Carpenter is currently incarcerated at a prison 17 in Corcoran in Kings County, which is within the venue of the Eastern District of California. 18 Venue is proper in a habeas action in either the district of confinement or the district of 19 conviction, 28 U.S.C. § 2241(d); however, a petition challenging a conviction is preferably 20 heard in the district of conviction. Habeas L.R. 2254-3(b). Because the conviction occurred 21 in the Eastern District of California, pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1404(a) and Habeas L.R. 2254-22 3(b), and in the interest of justice, this action is TRANSFERRED to the United States 23 District Court for the Eastern District of California. The clerk shall transfer this matter 24 forthwith.
