10 Pending before the Court are Defendants' motion to dismiss and pro hac vice applications.

11 Upon review of the record in this action, the Court notes that the parties have not filed written  
12 consents to Magistrate Judge James' jurisdiction. This civil case was randomly assigned to  
13 Magistrate Judge James for all purposes including trial. In accordance with Title 28, U.S.C. §  
14 636(c), the magistrate judges of this district court are designated to conduct any and all proceedings  
15 in a civil case, including trial and entry of final judgment, upon the consent of the parties. An appeal  
16 from a judgment entered by Magistrate Judge James may be taken directly to the United States Court  
17 of Appeals for the Ninth Circuit in the same manner as an appeal from any other judgment of a  
18 district court.

19 You have the right to have your case assigned to a United States District Judge for trial and  
20 disposition. Accordingly, the parties shall inform the Court whether they consent to Magistrate  
21 Judge James' jurisdiction or request reassignment to a United States District Judge for trial. A copy  
22 of both the consent and declination forms may be obtained from the Northern District of California's  
23 website at <http://www.cand.uscourts.gov/>. From the homepage, click on the "Forms" tab on the left  
24 margin, then choose "Civil." The parties shall inform the Court of their decision by October 29,  
25 2009.
