Judgment in this action to the United States Court of Appeals for the Ninth Circuit (Court of Appeals Case Number 11-17062) (hereinafter referred to as "Appeal"). 6

WHEREAS on September 1, 2011, Defendant Hewlett-Packard Company ("Defendant") filed a Bill of Costs;

WHEREAS on September 27, 2011, Plaintiffs filed a Motion to Defer Consideration of Defendant's Motions for Attorneys Fees And Costs Until After Appeal Is Completed;

WHEREAS on September 30, 2011, Defendant filed a Motion for Attorneys Fees, with a hearing set for November 4, 2011;

- Plaintiffs' Motion to Defer Consideration of the Motions for Fees and Costs shall 2. be taken off calendar; and
- The October 31, 2011 deadline for Plaintiffs to oppose Defendant's Bill of Costs 3. and Motion for Attorneys Fees and the November 4, 2011 hearing date on Defendant's Motion for Attorneys Fees shall be vacated.
