

**ORDER GRANTING IN PART AND
DENYING IN PART MOTION TO
COMPEL**

15 This is a personal injury action against a machine manufacturer relating to injuries sustained by
16 Plaintiff during his use of a “horizontal baler” machine” in the course of his employment. Fact
17 discovery closed on August 10, 2010. On August 17, 2010, the last day to file the motion under
18 Local Rule 26-2, Plaintiff filed a motion to compel relating to his request for production of
19 documents. For the reasons stated during oral argument, Plaintiff’s Motion is GRANTED IN PART
20 and DENIED IN PART. Defendant is hereby Ordered to provide a declaration of the person most
21 knowledgeable with respect to Defendant’s search efforts regarding safety labels, and the parties are
22 Ordered to further meet and confer on this issue. With respect to requests 5 and 10, Defendant’s
23 objection that the information is equally available to Plaintiff is overruled. Defendant is Ordered to
24 produce documents responsive to these requests that are within its custody or control.

25 **IT IS SO ORDERED.**
