 FILE CONSENT/DECLINATION

9 Pending before the Court is Plaintiff's in forma pauperis application. Upon review of the
 10 record in this action, the Court notes that Plaintiff has not filed a written consent to Magistrate Judge
 11 James' jurisdiction. This civil case was randomly assigned to Magistrate Judge James for all
 12 purposes including trial. In accordance with Title 28, U.S.C. § 636(c), the magistrate judges of this
 13 district court are designated to conduct any and all proceedings in a civil case, including trial and
 14 entry of final judgment, upon the consent of the parties. An appeal from a judgment entered by
 15 Magistrate Judge James may be taken directly to the United States Court of Appeals for the Ninth
 16 Circuit in the same manner as an appeal from any other judgment of a district court.

17 You have the right to have your case assigned to a United States District Judge for trial and
 18 disposition. Accordingly, Plaintiff shall inform the Court whether she consents to Magistrate Judge
 19 James' jurisdiction or requests reassignment to a United States District Judge for trial. A copy of
 20 both the consent and declination forms may be obtained from the Northern District of California's
 21 website at <http://www.cand.uscourts.gov/>. From the homepage, click on the "Forms" tab on the left
 22 margin, then choose "Civil." The consent/declination form shall be filed by September 3, 2009.
