Plaintiff filed the 5 Motion to Compel after engaging in a three week long effort to meet and confer to resolve the 6 issues raised therein. 7 3. On August 5, 2010, the parties received notice from the court that the discovery 8 dispute would be referred to a magistrate judge for handling. On August 10, 2010, the parties 9 received notice that the matter had been referred to magistrate Judge Edward Chen and the 10 matter was scheduled for hearing on September 22, 2010. 11 4. Plaintiff contends that the documents sought by her Motion to Compel are 12 necessary for Plaintiff to prepare a meaningful and fully informed brief in support of Class 13 Certification. Without expressing any position as to the merits of the Motion, in the event it is 14 granted, it is doubtful that Plaintiff will receive the responsive documents in sufficient time to 15 analyze them and incorporate the information into her Motion for Class Certification, which is 16 currently due to be filed on September 30, 2010. 17 5.
