17	On October 15, 2010, Joseph W. Strella, attorney for
18	defendant IZT Mortgage Corporation dba Ameritech, filed a
19	motion to withdraw as counsel on behalf of himself, P.
20	Christian Scheley, and their law firm Clapp, Moroney,
21	Bellagamba, Vucinich, Beeman & Scheley (collectively
22	"Strella").
23	Having considered the moving papers, and having received
24	no opposition from Ameritech or the other parties, ${f IT}$ ${f IS}$
25	HEREBY ORDERED that Mr. Strella's motion to withdraw as
26	counsel for Ameritech is GRANTED conditionally. Ameritech has
27	failed to pay for his services, has ignored counsel's repeated
28	attempts to communicate, and has had sufficient notice that
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1 counsel intended to withdraw.

2 Mr. Strella is granted a conditional withdrawal pursuant 3 to Civil Local Rule 11-5(b). While Mr. Strella is relieved of 4 his responsibilities as counsel for Ameritech, papers for 5 Ameritech may continue to be served on him, until Ameritech 6 appears by other counsel.

7 Given that Ameritech, as a corporation, cannot represent itself, (Rowland v. California Men's Colony, 506 U.S. 194, 8 201-202 (1993); Civil L.R. 3-9(b)), IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that 9 Ameritech must obtain new counsel. If substitute counsel do 10 11 not file a general appearance by January 14, 2011, Ameritech's default will be entered. Mr. Strella must serve this order on 12 13 Ameritech and inform it about the repercussions for failing to obtain alternate counsel. 14
