 20 WHEREAS Plaintiff Microsoft Corporation, a Washington corporation (“Microsoft”), and
 21 Defendants Coast Networks, Inc. aka DK Systems and Corby Brasset (collectively,
 22 “Defendants”), have settled the above-captioned matter; and

23 WHEREAS this Court has entered a Stipulated Permanent Injunction (“Permanent
 24 Injunction”) between Microsoft and Defendants;

25 **IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED** by and between Plaintiff, through its attorneys, and
 26 Defendants, through their attorneys, that Defendants Coast Networks, Inc. aka DK Systems and
 27 Corby Brasset, shall be dismissed with prejudice from Microsoft’s Complaint pursuant to Rule
 28

1 41(a) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, with each party to bear its own costs and attorneys'
2 fees.

3 **IT IS HEREBY FURTHER STIPULATED** that this Court shall retain jurisdiction to
4 enforce the Permanent Injunction entered by this Court and the Settlement Agreement and Release
5 between Microsoft and Defendants.
