On October 19, 2009, the Court ordered Plaintiff to either consent or decline 15 magistrate jurisdiction by November 3, 2009. (Dkt. #4.) Because Plaintiff failed to comply with this deadline, the Court again ordered Plaintiff to consent or decline, with a new deadline of 16 17 November 18, 2009. (Dkt. #5.) Plaintiff failed to respond. Based on Plaintiff's inaction the Court 18 issued an order for Plaintiff to show cause why sanctions should not be imposed for failure to 19 prosecute and comply with court deadlines. (Dkt. #6.)
