20 IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED by and between the parties that JUDGMENT be entered
 21 as follows:

23 1. Defendants Farmers Processing, Inc., a California Corporation and Raymond
 24 Rodriguez, personally, stipulate that judgment be entered jointly and severally against Farmers
 25 Processing, Inc. and Raymond Rodriguez (jointly "Defendants") in favor of Plaintiffs George

11 3. Plaintiffs are valid trust creditors under Section 5(c) of PACA, 7 U. S.C. Section
12 499e(c) against Farmers Processing.

13 4. Upon payment in full, Plaintiffs shall file a Notice of Satisfaction of Judgment
14 with the Court.

16 5. The parties jointly stipulate that in the event that any legal action or collection
17 actions is necessary to enforce the terms of this Stipulation, the prevailing party in such action
18 shall be entitled to recover its reasonable attorney's fees and costs.

19 6. This Stipulation may be executed in any number of counterparts, each of which
20 shall be an original, but all of which together shall constitute one instrument. The parties agree
21 that a facsimile signature shall be treated in all respects as having the same effect as an original
22 signature.
