**JOINT STIPULATION AND [PROPOSED]

13 respective positions and complete the Early Neutral Evaluation process; and
- 14 4. The parties further agree that this Stipulation is without prejudice to their seeking
15 further extensions or stays in the event that they are necessary to allow the parties to explore
16 amicable resolution of the litigation.

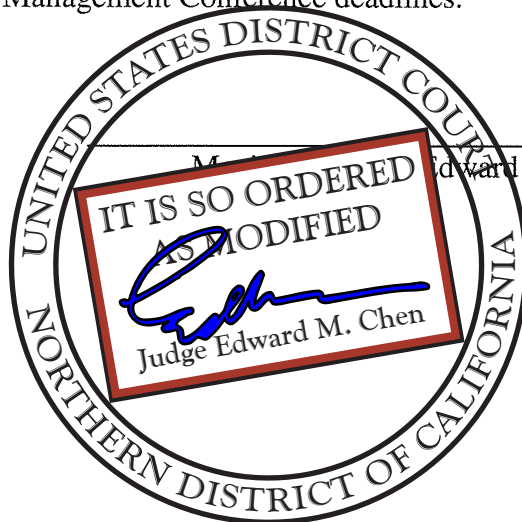
