



1 Counsel respectfully requests an extension of time of 90 days to file her Motion  
2 for Summary Judgment for the following reasons:

- 3 1. Ms. King was referred to me by the Bar Association of San Francisco.  
4 She has had a difficult time trying to find and retain an attorney and had  
5 spoken to a number of attorneys before she found me. She retained me  
6 today to represent her.
- 7 2. I have not represented Ms. King at any level prior to now; I am unfamiliar  
8 with her case. She has given me a transcript of 501 pages. In addition  
9 there are a number of other loose pages to review. Because of the  
10 deadline which the Court gave to Plaintiff (and which has already passed),  
11 I only quickly reviewed the Administrative Law Judge's decision and a few  
12 documents relating to her case to determine whether there was a basis to  
13 appeal. I believe there is but it will take me some time to review the file  
14 and prepare the Motion for Summary Judgment.
