No. 130). Furthermore, 20 defendant uPI Semiconductor Corporation failed to timely file a declaration supporting the 21 motion as required by Rule 79-5. Accordingly, the motion cannot be granted at this time. 22 23

The parties may cure these defects by **NOON ON DECEMBER 16, 2010**. No further extensions will be granted. The parties are urged to review and comply with Rule 79-5 regarding all future motions to file under seal.
