14 James may be taken directly to the United States Court of Appeals for the Ninth Circuit in the same  
15 manner as an appeal from any other judgment of a district court.

16 You have the right to have your case assigned to a United States District Judge for trial and  
17 disposition. Accordingly, Plaintiffs shall inform the Court whether they consent to Magistrate Judge  
18 James' jurisdiction or request reassignment to a United States District Judge for trial. A copy of

20 website at <http://www.cand.uscourts.gov/>. From the homepage, click on the "Forms" tab on the left  
21 margin, then choose "Civil." The consent/declination form shall be filed by December 17, 2009.
