14 Plaintiff, who is representing herself, filed this action in state court. Defendant PNC Bank,
15 National Association removed the case to this Court, and has filed motions to dismiss and to strike the
16 complaint. The motions are scheduled for a hearing on March 19, 2010. Plaintiff has filed a letter with
17 the Court requesting that the Court allow her time to find an attorney to represent her and to respond to
18 defendant's motions. The Court grants plaintiff's request for an extension of time. The March 19, 2010
19 hearing is rescheduled to **April 30, 2010** at 9:00 am. Plaintiff's response to the pending motions must
20 be filed no later than **April 9, 2010**, and defendant's replies must be filed no later than **April 16, 2010**.
21 The case management conference scheduled for April 16, 2010 is rescheduled **April 30, 2010** at 2:30
22 pm.

23 **The Court also finds it appropriate to refer the parties to the Court's Alternative Dispute**
24 **Resolution Program. The ADR Department shall contact the parties and arrange a conference**
25 **to determine the appropriate ADR procedure.**
