Plaintiff Rochelle Vaughn sued defendant Patrick R. Donahoe, Postmaster General, for disability discrimination, race discrimination, and retaliation. On July 19, 2011, plaintiff filed a petition for waiver of costs, arguing that her workers' compensation benefits have been cut off and that she lacks a steady source of income.
