**STIPULATION TO CONTINUE CASE
 MANAGEMENT CONFERENCE**

17 1. This is a wage and hour case in which Plaintiffs allege unpaid overtime under
 18 both Fair Labor Standards Act and California Labor Code.

19 2. The case was originally assigned to Judge Larson who did not set any case
 20 management schedule due to his anticipated retirement, except referring parties to a court
 21 sponsored mediation and settlement conference with Judge Zimmerman.

22 3. Parties have participated in the mediation and then a settlement conference
 23 before Judge Zimmerman on July 26, 2011. After a half-day negotiations, Judge Zimmerman
 24 continued the Settlement Conference to August 23, 2011 while ordering Defendants to provide
 25 certain information on their financial situation to facilitate the settlement negotiations. See
 Docket No. 53.

1 4. Given the continuation of the settlement negotiations being assisted by Judge
2 Zimmerman, parties hereby request that the currently Case Management Conference on August 4
3 to September 1, 2011, with the Joint Case Management Statement due on August 25, 2011.
