**RESPONSE TO "REQUEST FOR  
INFORMATION"**

14 Plaintiff has filed a "request for information," which asks: "When is plaintiff Buesgens required  
15 to file notice of appeal to the Ninth Circuit Court of Appeals?"

16 A notice of appeal must be timely filed with the clerk of the district court from which the appeal  
17 is taken. Fed. R. App. Pro. 3(a)(1). In general, a notice of appeal must be filed within 30 days after  
18 entry of the appealed judgment or order. Fed. R. App. Pro. 4(a)(1)(A).

19 It is plaintiff's responsibility to prosecute his own action, which includes doing the necessary  
20 research and investigation as to rules and deadlines. It is inappropriate for this Court to provide basic  
21 legal research to plaintiff and he is cautioned that he should file no more such "requests for information"  
22 with this Court.
