BRIEFING SCHEDULE**



17 The undersigned has reviewed the parties' stipulation seeking additional time for plaintiff
18 to file her summary judgment motion in this social security appeal. The reasons underlying the
19 request, however, do not warrant any extension, let alone the 30-day extension requested.
20 Specifically, the fact that counsel have taken on too much work and have other cases that "require
21 briefing prior to this date" is not a legitimate reason to extend court-ordered deadlines. Since the
22 motion deadline is imminent, however, the undersigned will grant plaintiff until **JUNE 28, 2010**, to
23 file the summary judgment motion. No further extensions will be granted.
