1 This Court entered an Order Re: Motion to Intervene and Defendants' Motions to  
2 Dismiss on August 25, 2010. In that Order, the Court granted the motion to dismiss of  
3 Defendant The Regents of the University of California, denied the other Defendants'  
4 motions to dismiss, and ordered Defendant-Intervenors to notice and file a motion to  
5 dismiss pursuant to Rule 12(b)(6), in light of *Coalition for Economic Equity v. Wilson*,  
6 122 F.3d 692 (9th Cir. 1997). That motion is to be heard by this Court on November 15,  
7 2010.

8 Plaintiffs and Defendant Mark Yudof, who is sued here in his official capacity as  
9 President of the University of California, have agreed and hereby stipulate that, in light of  
10 the Court's Order, Defendant Yudof may have until and including the thirtieth (30th) day  
11 after this Court rules on the Defendant-Intervenors' motion to dismiss in which to answer  
12 or otherwise respond further to the Complaint in this action. Plaintiffs and Defendant  
13 Yudof agree that such extension is appropriate to conserve the time and resources of both  
14 the parties and this Court.
