12 On August 6, 2012, this Court issued an Order Denying
13 Petition for Writ of Habeas Corpus and a Judgment in favor of
14 Respondent. See Docket ## 16, 17. These documents were sent to
15 Petitioner at the address he had listed with the Court but, on
16 August 21, 2012, this mail was returned as undeliverable. Doc. #18.
17 On December 12, 2012, Petitioner sent a letter to the Court with his
18 new address. Doc. #19. On December 20, 2012, the Court resent the
19 documents to Petitioner at his new address. Doc. #20. On January
20 2, 2013, Petitioner filed a notice of appeal. Doc. #21.

21 On September 26, 2013, the Court received an Order from
22 the Ninth Circuit Court of Appeals construing Petitioner's notice of
23 appeal as a motion to reopen the time for appeal pursuant to Federal
24 Rule of Appellate Procedure 4(a)(6) and remanding the appeal to this
25 Court for the limited purpose of allowing it to rule on the January
26 2, 2013 motion.

27 The Court finds that Petitioner's motion to reopen meets
28 all of the requirements of Federal Rule of Appellate Procedure

1 4(a)(6). Good cause appearing, the Court grants Petitioner's motion
2 to reopen the time to file an appeal.

3 The Clerk of the Court shall send a copy of this order to
4 Petitioner and to the Ninth Circuit Court of Appeals.
